

- **Alberta Health order Effective Sept 4, 2021** –Masks are mandatory in all indoor public spaces and workplaces.

#### **Campground information – Effective Sept 4, 2021**

- Masks are required within all indoor buildings.
- Camping units with self-contained washroom/shower facilities are encouraged to use their own facilities. Tents are accepted. Washrooms and showers are open and available.
- Continue to wash your hands or use hand sanitizer before and after using our facilities. Our buildings are off limits to persons who are required to quarantine.
- We will attempt to accommodate special needs, please contact us directly.
- Keep in mind that not all surfaces can be fully disinfected (i.e picnic tables, play grounds, garbage containers, books, water taps, sewer connections, etc) practice good hygiene, regularly wash your hands and avoid touching your face after touching surfaces on this property.
- Unvaccinated persons are strongly recommended to limit indoor social gatherings to close contacts of only 2 cohort families, up to a maximum of 10 people.
- Site registration and payment are being accepted remotely.
- Insure your site is left clean of debris (including cigarette butts) and disposed in designated garbage/recycle containers.
